Enrolments & Term payments:

If you have not already filled out an enrolment form, I ask that you do so as soon as possible. Enrolment forms are online via our website www.studioonedance.com.au or there are hard copies available in the dance studio.

Term fees will be invoiced to you, via email, next week and are due within 7 days. Fees not paid by the due date will incur a \$25 administration fee, per term, unless prior arrangements have been made with me. If you require special payment arrangements, please contact me to discuss.

Included in Term 1 invoice is a one off fee of \$30.00 per year for APRA licensing, insurance & administration, as well as a \$50.00 costume fee, for costumes for our end of year performances.

- A 15% discount off your term account will apply to those families that enroll in any three classes

Uniform:

Please make sure your child wears the proper attire to dancing, has her hair tied back and brings a drink to class. Also please make sure your child goes to the toilet before class.

Our uniform consists of the Studio One t-shirt or singlet & black ¾ leggings. This is compulsory for all classes, unless your child still chooses to wear a leotard.

In the cooler weather, crossovers or hoodies are permissible for all ages.

Studio One t-shirts and singlet's and hoodies are available to order, by filling out the attached order form, placing monies in an envelope and handing to

your teacher at your next class, or you can transfer monies into my account with description - child's name and item purchasing. (eg HRamsaytee)

We have some singlet's, t-shirts & hoodies in stock but I will be doing another order this term, if the size your require is not in stock.

Shoes:

All children should have proper ballet/jazz and tap shoes for dancing by Term 2.

We do have a second hand shoe box located in the dance studio for those of you wishing to sell or purchase shoes.

When bringing your child's shoes into sell please make sure you clearly mark them with name & price & fill out the log book.

If buying new shoes Eergetiks in Ivanhoe, have our school's uniform list. I also personally recommend MDM ballet shoes, these shoes provide greater support & strength, and are available from Pointe to Pointe in Greensborough, or Kids On Broadway in Reservoir.

Please note: all black jazz shoes need to split soled, and tap shoes a low heel (Intermediate tap can move up to a Cuban heel)



End of year performances:

We are looking at having our concerts at MAGIS theatre, Loyola College again this year. I did ask for Friday night & Saturday matinee (1st weekend in Dec) but as the school has things on that weekend, the only option that I was given is Thursday night & Saturday morning.

Dates as follows:

Dress rehearsal: Monday 30th Nov; 5.00-8.30pm.

Concerts: Thursday 3rd Dec; 6.30pm & Saturday 5th Dec; 10.00am

I have also contacted Viewbank College to see if they can better accommodate us and will keep you posted on any changes.

Costumes:

We will be purchasing all costumes for our end of year performances, therefore there is no sewing to be done.

A fee of \$50.00 has been added to your Term 1 invoice to allow me to start buying samples. This is non-refundable.

Depending on how many classes your child is doing another \$50.00 fee may be applicable in Term 2.

The remaining costs will be tallied towards the end of Term 3, and the balance due, prior to you receiving your costumes. Once costumes are fully paid for they are yours to keep.

Costume costs will range between \$55-\$60 per costume.

Parent watching:

Parents are allowed to watch for the first few weeks of Term 1, so that new students feel comfortable. We then ask that parents remain outside the studio whilst class is in progress for the benefit of all students and teachers; as it does become distracting.

We do have one watching week each term & that will take place on the **fifth** week of each term. This term it is the week beginning 2nd March, so please feel free to come into class that week.

Signing in and out:

Unfortunately, it is hard for us to monitor the entire going on before students enter or leave the center, therefore as parents, we ask that you drop off and pick your children up on time.

Older students will be permitted to wait at reception for collection however all younger students (10 and under) will not be allowed to leave the studio and you will need to sign them in and out of class.

Please be diligent in signing your child in & out.

We will be learning exam work this term with exams held towards the end of Term 2.

Exams do provide a crucial part of learning; they give students the opportunity to develop strength, flexibility & confidence. They also give students the ability to work towards something other than our end of year concerts.

Your child will be learning the exam syllabus in class, however sitting the exam is not compulsory; it is then up to you and your child to decide whether or not he/she would like to sit the exam.

On passing, all students will receive a certificate and a medal.
